PURPOSE OF JOB

PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTABILITIES

2. Delivering and maintaining the effective implementation of school policies, schemes of work and related practice for all subjects but with particular emphasis on English and mathematics.
3. To oversee the continued care and welfare of pupils within your designated class.
4. To plan, prepare, deliver and assess lessons that enable each individual pupil to succeed and make rapid progress.
5. To assist in building and maintaining positive relationships between colleagues, parents, governors, the local community and the school.
6. To oversee the delivery of an effective curriculum subject area throughout the school leading to high expectations and standards. A comprehensive list of key tasks is available from the school.
7. To be aware of health and safety issues and work within the guidelines of the Health and Safety Policy.
8. To meet, in full, the requirements of the Teacher Standards.
