Reablement Competencies

Bespoke programme created for JCR to give workers theoretical knowledge and practical skills in the following areas:

- Reablement
- Exercise
- Mobility
- Transfers
- Anti-embolism stockings
- Catheter bags
- Pressure area care
- Nutrition
- Swallowing

Competence is assessed through worksheets and practical assessments

Apprenticeships

New and existing workers are able to further enhance their skills and knowledge, and gain a recognised qualification, by completing an apprenticeship with Adult Social Care.

Apprenticeships available include:

Level 2 - Adult Care Worker

Level 3 - Lead Adult Care Worker

Apprenticeships consist of a blended programme of learning at work, taught sessions and learning sets.

All staff who choose to complete an apprenticeship will be given the support of an assessor to guide them through the process.

Staff with no qualifications in English or Maths will be additionally supported to achieve a qualification in these areas.

- Understanding the Safe Handling of Medication
- Falls Prevention Awareness
- Understanding Safeguarding and Prevent
