
The qualification requires the creation of a portfolio of evidence relating to your job role. The portfolio work is usually completed within 12 months and your external End Point Assessment within 3 months of completion of Diploma. You would be expected to commit to study for at least 4 hrs per month during this time.

To help you complete your course, you will be allocated a Heathercroft Training Academy Assessor who will arrange to meet with you on a regular basis. Your Assessor will help you to identify appropriate evidence for your portfolio and ensure that it meets the required standards. Learners will need to show competence in both knowledge and skills and will be internally assessed by a range of methods. These include assessor observations within the workplace, written assignments, witness testimonies from colleagues or others and written assignments.

Your portfolio will be an e portfolio which is web based and will be created from work-based evidence relating to the NCFE Standards.

To gain the Level 2 Healthcare Support Worker qualification you must achieve a minimum of 46 credits. There are 14-16 competence units to complete, 9 of which are Mandatory Units and a range of optional units depending on your job role and the pathway chosen.



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
