I have pleasure in sending you an application form, further information about the vacancy, and what it's like working for our school.

Brunswick Primary School is a newly formed school from two existing separate schools on the site. The merger took place to form the primary school in September 2015. This has given us the opportunity to create something very special from two widely regarded and positively supported schools. Our aim is to provide a dynamic and exciting education which meets the needs of our ever evolving community.

Brunswick is a primary school with approximately 890 pupils on roll. Our children receive a creative education, rich with direct experience that they find exciting, challenging and fulfilling. Their contributions are valued and the experiences they are offered are planned to reflect their stage of development. We cherish and promote creativity in all aspects of school life, and staff are skilled at developing creative approaches to thinking, learning and teaching.

The school is currently divided into four classes per year group with five classes in two year groups due to an increasing demand for school places in our community. Although we are a large school we are keen to ensure that we know all of children as individuals so that we are able to cater for their differing needs appropriately.

The curriculum is designed to find and develop the talents and interests of each child and emphasises the importance of creative and cultural opportunities for learning. Much of the children's work at Brunswick is organised as cross-curricular Learning Quests, offering the children an opportunity to make links between subjects and begin to develop a lifelong love of learning.

These roles will involve generalist work and at least some time working one to one with individual children.
