| Question 3: | What experience and training do you have of safeguarding and child protection issues and procedures? |
| Question 4: | What is your understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage guidance and how have you used this, including planning and organisational skills, record keeping, written reports and planning for the EYFS. |
| Question 5: | Tell us about your experience of providing care and education to children from a wide range of backgrounds, including those with special educational needs and disabilities. |
| Question 6: | What is the importance of the key person system and attachment? How you have used this knowledge when working with young children? |

Think carefully about how you can answer the questions by considering what you have done in the past

If you have little or no work experience, think about the skills you developed at school, home, college, through voluntary work or a hobby that you can transfer to the workplace

Provide practical examples of real life situations of when and how you used the particular knowledge, skill or experience
